

Mark Burrell is best known for his work on Broadway and abroad. Currently he is a Visiting Artist-In-Residence at Southern Methodist University. Mark is a graduate of the Juilliard School in New York City, where was on the faculty as a summer instructor, master teacher, and choreographer. He also holds an MFA in Interdisciplinary Arts from Wilson College. His performance experience is extensive throughout the United States and internationally, including engagements in Israel, Japan, Zambia, Peru, and South Africa. Mark made his Broadway debut in the First National Tour of Fosse and served as the Assistant Director, Associate Choreographer, Dance Captain, and Swing for PIPPIN on Broadway as well as the First National Tour and International Tour. Mark was the Assistant Choreographer for Radio City Music Hall's Christmas Spectacular starring the Rockettes for 10 years. He is featured in the motion picture, *The Producers: A Movie Musical*. Other theatrical productions include: *CATS*, Disney's *Beauty and the Beast*, Broadway for Hilary, and *Seven Brides for Seven Brothers*. Television credits include: CBS's *Late Show with David Letterman* and NBC's *Late Night with Conan O'Brien*. Mark has been involved in numerous industrials for such companies as Macy's, Ford Motor Company, Intel Computers, IBM, and Tupperware. He has also engaged in the classical and contemporary works of Chet Walker with his company WalkerDance as a principle dancer, Azure Barton, Lar Lubovich, Paul Taylor, Jiri Kylian, Lila York, and David Parker and The Bang Group where he was an honorary guest artist. Mark has taught in many studios across the nation as well as internationally including The Joffrey Ballet, Tokyo Ballet, Broadway Dance Center in Japan, The Institute for the Blind, Instituto Cultural Peruano Norteamericano (ICPNA), Point Park University, Rochester Institute of Technology, Butler University, and Jacob's Pillow Dance Festival.
